## CDC GUIDELINES FOR POOLS

Play it safe around and in swimming pools, hot tubs, and water playgrounds, and keep space between yourself and others. Evidence suggests that COVID-19 cannot be spread to humans through most recreational water. Additionally, proper operation of these aquatic venues and disinfection of the water (with chlorine or bromine) should inactivate SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes COVID-19. Swimming and other water-related activities are excellent ways to get the physical activity needed for a healthy life. Taking steps to reduce the spread of COVID-19 is one way you can play it safe in and around swimming pools, hot tubs, and water playgrounds.

- Don't visit a swimming pool if you are sick with, tested positive for, or were recently exposed to COVID-19.
- Practice social distancing by staying at least 6 feet (two meters) from people you don't live with.
- Keep your hands clean by washing hands with soap and water, especially after going to the bathroom, before eating, and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.
- Adults and older children who can safely use hand sanitizer: Use hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol and rub hands together until dry, if soap and water are not readily available.

## Family Swim Program

### Flexible membership terms

- Enroll by the week for a minimum of five weeks.
- Weeks need not be consecutive.
- Sign our “Members Use Agreement”.
- Daily passes will not be offered to the general public.

### Swim at your own risk

- The pools are open daily 10:00 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. with the exception of week-days when the Day Camp is in session. On weekdays during the Day Camp season the pools are open to members from 4:15 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.
- Most hours of operation will be un-guarded. Lifeguards may be posted dur-

ing predictable periods of heavy usage. (This aspect is an important one to consider before joining. Call us to discuss any concerns.)

### Shared Use of Pools

- When groups rent our facilities for a picnic or outing, the north pool (farthest from parking) will be reserved for family members. Rarely, in cases of large group numbers, a rental group may be granted use of both pools. In that case, the north pool would accommodate both pool members and picnic attendees. We apologize for any inconvenience.

### Guests

- \$15 per visit for a family of guests
- \$5 per individual guest

- Fees payable in the camp office breezeway
- Multiple visits by local guests are discouraged—encourage them to join!
- Large groups of guests are not allowed without prior approval

**MEMBER USE AGREEMENT  
FOR  
HOLIDAY RECREATION CENTER, INC. (HOLIDAY HILL)**

***Terms and Conditions***

\*Rules for acceptance and participation in programs at HOLIDAY HILL are the same for everyone without regard to age, race, color, religion, sex, handicap, or national origin.

**1. Description of Premises** – HOLIDAY HILL agrees to permit Members to use the property identified in the Agreement as “Facility” according to the following terms and conditions. The Agreement includes the use of the Pool Complex, Bathhouse and adjacent lawn, picnic, and parking areas; all recreational areas of the Facility, with the following exceptions: a) The picnic and recreational facilities on the lower camp will not be available to members during scheduled events when the facility has been rented by a user group; b) All Adventure Ropes Course elements and areas containing elements are off-limits; c) Any areas that HOLIDAY HILL expressly excludes by so notifying the Members upon arrival at the Facility or by posting with appropriate signage; d) The Tree Swing may be used only with adult supervision and in accordance with posted rules, and when the Ropes Course is not in use.

**2. Use of Premises** – The term and rate information contained in the annual HOLIDAY HILL brochure and registration form are integral parts of this Agreement. During the term of this Agreement, Members shall use the Facility for conducting recreational and leisure activities and shall comply with all applicable laws, codes, and regulations. Members shall notify HOLIDAY HILL of the nature of any other activity and shall promptly supply HOLIDAY HILL with information concerning the program upon request. HOLIDAY HILL prohibits hunting, fireworks, firearms, ammunition, and explosives at the Facility. The use of gasoline, flammables, poisonous substances, and hand and power tools are restricted. Prior authorization from the Site Director must be obtained.

**3. Maintenance** – HOLIDAY HILL shall maintain the Facility in good condition and repair and shall provide janitorial services to the premises and buildings. Members agree to assist in keeping the Facility clean and shall leave the Facility free of litter and defacement.

**4. Schedule** -- Swimming pools are generally available from early June through late August, weather and maintenance requirements permitting. Availability at other times is at the discretion of the Site Director and is subject to change. When the gates are locked the pools are closed and their use is prohibited. Members may not climb over the fence and swim when the pools are closed.

**Regular Hours:** The pools are open daily 10:00 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. with the exception of days when the Day Camp is in session. On Weekdays during the Day Camp season the pools are open to members from 4:15 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.

**Pool Maintenance Work:** Regular maintenance work is scheduled outside of regular hours of operation whenever possible. From time to time it may be necessary to perform maintenance tasks during regular hours. At those times pool use will be at the discretion of the maintenance workers.

**Weather:** HOLIDAY HILL may close the pools during inclement weather at its discretion.

**Lightning:** HOLIDAY HILL will close the pools when lightning conditions are present. In keeping with National Severe Storm Laboratory guidelines, when thunder is evident within 30 seconds of a lightning flash (indicating a six-mile proximity) the pool area shall be cleared. Pools may re-open 30 minutes after the last thunder is heard.

**5. Lifeguards** – During most hours of operation the pools will not be guarded. When Lifeguards are not present, adult Members and their families may use the pools at their own risk during regular hours. No person under 18 years of age shall enter the pool area without a parent or guardian unless a qualified lifeguard is supervising the pool area. An attempt will be made to track regular times of heavy usage and to provide guards at those times in order to try to prevent accidents and to respond to emergencies.

HOLIDAY HILL shall, in its sole discretion, determine the minimum qualifications for said lifeguards, which will generally be a minimum of a Red Cross Lifeguard Certificate. HOLIDAY HILL lifeguards are, for the most part, our summer camp staff members. They have undergone our camp counselor training in addition to their American Red Cross Lifeguard Training. They have a specific understanding of safe

practices at our pools and have full authority to make judgments as to the appropriateness or inappropriateness of certain behaviors at certain times. Members' cooperation and support with respect to the Lifeguards' duties is required.

**6. Supervision** – Parents and guardians of families with children need to supervise their children at the HOLIDAY HILL pools with respect to safety and cooperation with other members. Lifeguards are not expected to exercise this parental responsibility. Children unattended by responsible family members or guardians may not be left at our pools.

**7. Health and Safety** – Lifeguards will provide First Aid and CPR in accordance with their training. Emergency transportation is available through local emergency response groups by dialing 911. HOLIDAY HILL phones at the Facility office will be available for emergency use. **Members should use their own cell phones for emergency assistance.** Members agree to furnish non-emergency transportation.

**8. Vehicular Traffic** -- Use of vehicles at the Facility is restricted to roads and parking areas designated by the Site Director. The posted camp speed limit is 10 mph and shall be obeyed. Please refrain from driving on the grass, except in the pool parking lot.

**9. Members' Guests** – Members Guests may accompany them to the pools at a rate of \$15 per visit by a family of Guests, \$5 per individual guest. Guest fees may be paid in the camp office, breezeway, or by mail. Inviting local guests for multiple visits is discouraged.

**10. Liability for Injury to Persons or Property** -- Member agrees to supervise and to assume full control and responsibility for any persons, or things on the Facility by reason of Member's use of the Facility. Member agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless HOLIDAY HILL and its past, present and future members, directors, officers, employees, agents, and independent contractors and its and their successors, assigns and heirs from and against any harm and/or claim made by any third party arising out of, or in any way connected with, Member's actions and/or failure(s) to act in respect of its use of the Facility. For the purpose of this section, "any person" includes, but is not limited to, Member's agents and employees, participants in Member's family, program, and Member's Guests or visitors. HOLIDAY HILL reserves the right to require that the Member remove from the Facility any persons in any way connected with, Member who, in the sole opinion of HOLIDAY HILL, are creating a disturbance or who are otherwise disrupting activities on said Facility.

**11. Termination** -- HOLIDAY HILL may terminate this Agreement without any liability upon ten (10) days prior written notice to Member either 1) without cause, or 2) upon a determination by HOLIDAY HILL, in its sole and exclusive judgment, that the requirements of the State Fire Marshal, the Department of Public Health and Safety or any statute, rule or regulation of any federal, state, or local body, imposes undue requirements or hardship on HOLIDAY HILL.


