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Campership Assistance Program Guidelines

- A \$25 Campership Deposit is due at the time of application. This deposit will be returned if a full campership is awarded or if Campership Assistance is unavailable for any reason. This deposit will be subtracted from any partial Campership fees awarded and the balance is due two weeks prior to the start of the camp session. If a family is unable to make a full payment by this time, they may develop a payment program in consultation with our office after enrollment is confirmed.
- Mansfield's Holiday Hill Day Camp campership awards are contingent upon the availability of funds in our American Camp Association Camper Scholarship Program account, space in the camp, and completion of the documentation requested in the application process.
- Mansfield's Holiday Hill Day Camp strives to be generous and accessible for all who would benefit from the camp experience, regardless of ability to pay. Aside from income, we look at the number of children in the household and extenuating circumstances such as family member illness, family members in college, change in employment status, prior participation in Holiday Hill Day Camp program, etc.
- Campership Applications are reviewed when received and awarded periodically as funds are available in our American Camp Association Camper Scholarship Program account.
- No other discounts or promotions may be used in conjunction with the Campership program.

Standards for Eligibility of Campership Recipients

The following standards qualify a Campership applicant for Holiday Hill's Campership Assistance program. Financial information is submitted as part of the Campership Application Process. Camper and family characteristics are determined by documents submitted and conversations conducted with parents of applicants. References submitted are also taken into consideration.

- Aged 4-14 years
- Motivated and excited to participate in the Holiday Hill Day Camp program
- Respectful of others and able to follow the guidelines of positive group dynamics
- Plays well with others and will enrich the camp community by their participation
- Able to perform the physical tasks required of the general program
- Camper's family supports his/her full participation
- Has a minimum C average or equivalent as indicated on recent scholastic progress reports submitted in the application process
- Camper's family is otherwise unable to afford camp tuition, as indicated on income and expense documents submitted in the application process
- Camper may be recommended for camp participation by school or agency professional staff
