






MEET OUR DIRECTORS

Hi everyone, l'm Dudley!



WHAT SHOULD I PACK?



WHAT WILL MY MORNING LOOK LIKE?



Every camper's morning looks a little different at camp. Some take the bus and some get dropped off in a car! No matter how you get here, you will get dropped off




WHAT WILL MY DAY LOOK LIKE?

BIG WHITE TENT




This is the big white tent that you will see during drop-off time. Some groups eat lunch under here. Some groups play games in the shade under the big white tent too!



coops to get out of the sun and store their backpacks.




Did you know Holiday Hill used to be a chicken farm? The coops used to have real chickens living in them, of course that was a long time ago! Now some groups use their



FINCHES' TENTS






The Lean-Tos are another place at camp where groups will store their backpacks or relax if needed! The Lean-Tos are for the Hawks and Eagles, which are the two




THE POOLS




THE AMPHITHEATER

on the stage with your group.





SPECIALISTS



ROPES COURSE



CANOEING


State Park. Have you ever been canoeing before?

PLAYGROUND/BASKETBALL COURT




We have a playground at camp too, and a basketball court! On the playground there are swings, slides, and even a train to play in! Groups use the basketball court to play basketball and other fun games too!



BIG SWING



MINI GOLF






The last thing I will show you is our mini golf course. Can you believe we have our own mini golf course at camp? How cool! Have you ever played mini golf before?


MORE FUN CAMP ACTIVITIES
